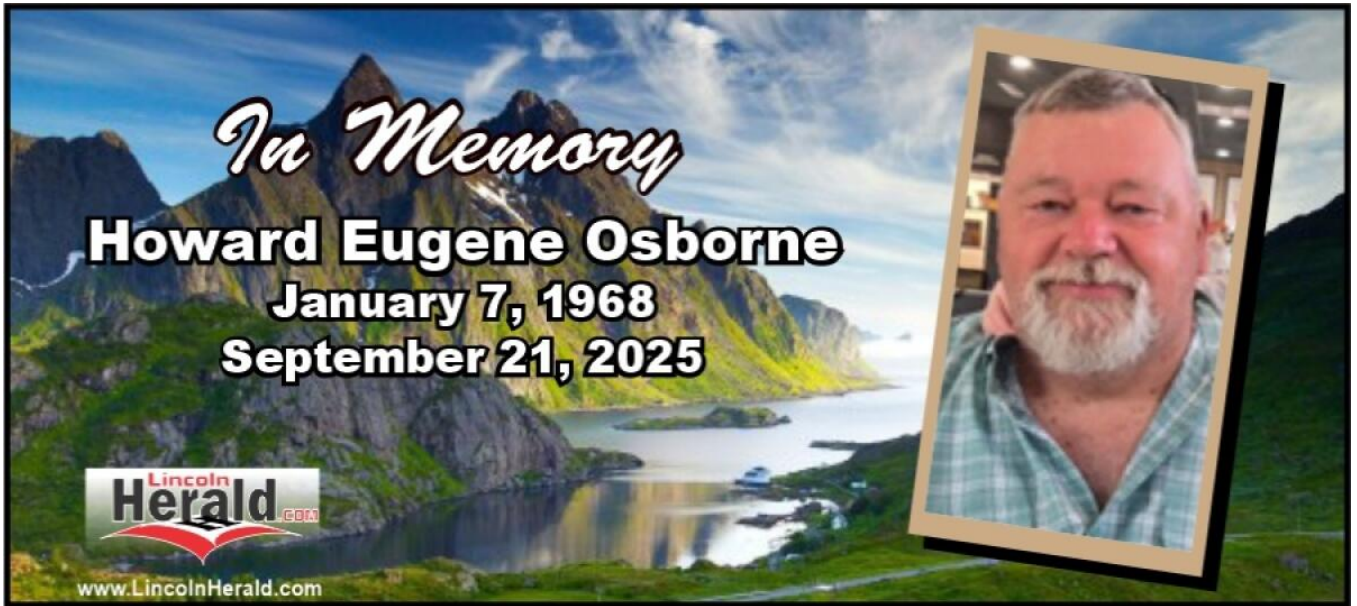




Howard Eugene Osborne!
