Roger Dale Walker, 71, of Lincolnton, NC, passed away peacefully on April 12, 2025. A devoted husband, loving father, proud Popaw, and faithful servant, Roger leaves behind a legacy of hard work, kindness, and a heart for others. He was born June 16, 1953 in Lincoln County and was the son of the late Elvin and the late Pearl Byrd Hill.
